TECHNICAL - SPARE PARTS POSITION MELBOURNE

The distributors of Jowett parts for Victoria, F.W. Henry's, are unfortunately leaving this field. This places members in Victoria in a rather grim position, and throws added responsibility on the Club. Some parts have already been offered for sale, in bulk, and since the entire finance of the Club is required for the continued manufacture of hard to get parts, and for the importation of other parts from England, it seemed as if the parts offered, would have to be returned to the N.S.W. agents, Hercules Motors. Rather than have this occur, resulting in all parts having to be sent from Sydney, the Committee have purchased these parts as a private venture.

They consist of a large quantity of Javelin and Bradford body panels, in addition to engine and other components. Complete doors, and door skins, bonnets, boot lids, window glass, radiators, choke and bonnett control wires, and a large variety of engine and gear box components are available. A substantial discount will be made available to members (financial) on any parts purchased. Non-members will have to pay the ruling retail prices. Stocks of gasket sets, bearings, and other misc-ellaneous parts may be obtained from Wheelans Automotive Spare Parts, in North Road, Bentleigh, and we recommend this firm to all Melbourne members, more information may be obtained on this matter at the annual meeting.

SPARE PARTS FROM ENGLAND

A letter is now being drafted. to Jowetts, England for the supply to the Club, of urgently needed parts, such as crankshafts, camshafts, and certain hard to get front end items. The Club has been granted an import liscence for some £300-0-0, this however may not now be necessary, due to the recent lifting of import restrictions. Some doubt still exists, as to whether Jowett Engineering will actually supply parts to the Club direct, but we are hoping that they will, particularly now that the local agents are out.

SUPPLY OF PARTS FROM THE CLUB

Members are reminded that all officers on the Executive Committee are honary only, and requests for parts to be sent at a moments notice, Is causing considerable worry. It must be realised that a considerable amount of running around Is involved on the part of the Parts Co-ordinator, in his own time, and at his expense, as the fees charged by the Club only cover freight or postage. I would ask members therefor to allow a reasonable time in which the required parts may be obtained and despatched, it certainly cannot be done in a matter of days.

Whilst on this subject, the Club rule that parts to the value of up to £5-0-0, would be sent on request, has now been rescinded. Unfortunately about £20 worth of parts have been sent to members who have not seen fit to remit the charges. All parts therefor will need to be paid for, prior to despatch. in future. Please understand that this is being done to protect your interests, as depletion of the Club funds in this manner, means less parts able to be purchased.

CHANGEOVER DISTRIBUTOR

A changeover distributor will be available to Club members very shortly. The unit will be of the DKY-H4A type, as fitted to the earlier Javelins, and will consist of the body only, completely overhauled and re-bushed, together with a new cam assembly. The members own cap and point set would be used on the reconditioned body. Cost of this service has not as yet been assessed, and more details will be given in the next issue of the News.

CLUB KITS

It is the intention of the Club to produce notes and/or drawings, to accompany any kits sold to members, who wish to do the nescessary work themselves. These notes will be issued at an early date, and will cover initially, the front end modification kits, and the gearbox kit, these being the most popular with members. I had a ride in a Javelin which has just had a front end job completed, and believe me, the difference, and absolute lack of road and suspension noise must be seen to be believed. Handling on corners also seems to be markedly improved. This car could be turned at considerably higher speeds than normal, without any suggestion of tyre squeal.
